WHY SHOULD YOUR LEADERS RECEIVE THIS TRAINING?

There is a growing realisation that the general likelihood of an accident occurring depends not just on the actions of individual employees but also on the safety culture of the organisation.

Consequently creating a positive safety culture is recognised as an essential aspect of effective safety management in any workplace. Safety culture is determined by the values and priorities placed on all aspects of safety by everyone at every level of an organisation, and how managers, supervisors and the workforce behave on a day-to-day basis.

A successful safety culture relies on strong leadership to create, communicate and model a vision where all employees are fully engaged at every level and are inspired to strive for that vision.
